

## 20 Bible Verses on Gratitude

### Thankfulness in All Circumstances

- 1 Thessalonians 5:18 – *“Give thanks in all circumstances; for this is God’s will for you in Christ Jesus.”*
- Colossians 3:17 – *“Whatever you do... do it all in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God the Father through him.”*

- Revelation 11:17 – *“We give thanks to you, Lord God Almighty... because you have taken your great power and have begun to reign.”*

## Thankfulness in Relationships

- Philippians 1:3 – *“I thank my God every time I remember you.”*
- 1 Thessalonians 1:2 – *“We always thank God for all of you and continually mention you in our prayers.”*
- 2 Timothy 1:3 – *“I thank God, whom I serve... as night and day I constantly remember you in my prayers.”*
- Colossians 1:3 – *“We always thank God, the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, when we pray for you.”*
